WORSHIP & SPIRITUALITY

It is surprising, when we look at it, just how many helpers are needed to properly put on our various liturgical and spirituality ministries.

It isn't only the priest or the deacon, but many others, from those who help us find a seat, to those who sing and play the music to those who count the collection afterwards. These and more are needed to present a prayerful and inspiring liturgy.

If you can help us here, it would not usually be an every week thing. We randomly schedule and freely take subs. We do need your help and participation — after all, wouldn't it be a bit lonely if it was only the priest and you?

WORSHIP & SPIRITUALITY

Adult Faith Formation

Periodically, we offer faith sharing, small faith groups and religious presentations for our parish adults. We need your help in setting up, bringing a treat or clean up after.

Advent Candle

During the four Sundays of Advent, we ask a family or individual to process in, with the servers, with an Advent candle and place it in the Advent Wreath holder. There is nothing to say—only move forward and place the candle.

Bereavement Group

A new parish group is Seasons of Hope. This is for those working through the loss of a loved one or who have a serious illness to deal with. We could use help with set up and bringing treats.

Cantor/Musicians

If you can sing (even a little) we need you! The cantor picks out hymns and leads the assembly at Mass in the sung responses and the hymns. Also, if you play keyboard, PLEASE help by spelling our regular musician.

Choir

Our choir is small but robust! The purpose is not to drown out the assembly, but to inspire us in song. If you like to sing in the shower, we can use your help. The choir sings periodically from around Labor Day to Memorial Day.

Chrism Mass Representative

Each year, on Tuesday of Holy Week, we need two representatives to attend the Chrism Mass with Deacon Mike and receive the blessed oils. These two then present them to the parish at the Mass on Holy Thursday.

Collection Counter

On the Monday following each weekend Mass, several people gather to count, tally and deposit the weekend collection in the bank. If you can count and also like to socialize, we can use your help!

Eucharistic Minister

A Eucharistic minister is someone who knows how to distribute holy communion during a Mass. We need helpers to do this. The training is short and easy, and you are only scheduled every few weeks or so. Can you help us?

First Friday Minister

On the First Friday of each month, we offer Eucharistic Adoration after the morning communion service. We need someone to put out the candelabra, distribute the prayer pamphlets and close up at 4 pm.

Food for the Soul

On the last Friday of the month, we offer a short spirituality presentation, along with treats and beverages. If you can help set up, or bring treats, Deacon Mike will do the rest.

Greeter

It's always nice to be greeted warmly when you enter a house or building. Well, that's all our greeters do. If you can smile and say hello and hand out a hymnal, you have all the training we need! Plus, you are not scheduled every week.

Lector

A lector is someone who proclaims the readings at Mass. With a little training, you too can be a lector. You are not scheduled each week, and subs are o.k.

RCIA

We need parishioners who want to learn a bit more about the faith, as they accompany someone entering the Church. Deacon Mike leads the team, but we need more members to help the new person explore the choice to become Catholic.

<u>Usher</u>

Ushers are indispensable for the Mass and helping members of the assembly find a place. Ushers also lock the church, secure the collection and take a count of the people attending Mass. You are not scheduled each week, and the more ushers, the easier the scheduling!
